Tim Britton's Masterwork piece is a metal replica spear of the spear made by "magic-men" for Shaka in the movie "Shakazulu." It is forged in the traditional manner and true to the original style. The blade will be Damascus steel and the shaft will be formed from African Blackwood.

Britton has been making knives since 1971 and has been a member of The Knifemaker's Guild since 1973. His work has been featured in all major cutlery publications and is displayed at eight to ten shows per year. Britton knives are used throughout the world; most notably as part of the issue to the palace guard detachment in Ivory Coast, Africa.

He has virtually all of the "super-steels" in his shop and access to others for any special needs. All handle materials, from lapis lazuli to Fiji fire pearl to the most common canvas micarta are hand-picked by Britton from suppliers at shows or in their shops.
